



DRINKING WATER IN YOUR FLAT

Information // Responsibilities // Tips



INTENDED USE OF DRINKING WATER

Drinking water may only be used for:

- › Drinks and food preparation
- › Personal care and hygiene (washing, showering, bathing)
- › Household cleaning (dishes, laundry, etc.)
- › other standard household uses (flushing the toilet, watering flowers, etc.)

ENSURING DRINKING WATER QUALITY

- › Use all sampling points daily if possible, or at least every 3 days
- › Use only suitable and approved equipment and fittings
- › Do not make any unauthorised alterations to the drinking water system



PREVENTING CONTAMINATION

- › No permanent hose or equipment connections without a non-return valve
- › Do not immerse hoses or fittings in containers containing chemicals or cleaning agents
- › Do not hang cleaning wipes over taps (risk of contamination)



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE (BY RESIDENTS)

- › Clean the taps on the washbasin, sink, shower and bath regularly
- › Descaling shower heads and aerators if they are limescale-encrusted or dirty
- › Replace shower hoses if they show any visible signs of damage



FUNCTIONAL CHECK

Please check regularly:

- › Is the water pressure sufficient?
- › Are the hot and cold water systems working properly?
- › Is it possible to fully open and close all the taps without having to use much force?

REPORTING DEFECTS

Please notify the landlord or property management company immediately in the event of:

- › Discolouration and changes in smell or taste
- › Fluctuations in water pressure or water outages
- › visible damage or leaks
- › Suspected hygiene issues

NOTE

- › Close and reopen the shut-off valves in your home once a year
- › Once a year, turn off the angle valves under washbasins and sinks completely, turn them back on, and then close them by a quarter turn
- › **After a prolonged absence (e.g. holiday)**, run the water from all taps for at least 3 minutes, **first using cold water and then hot water**, ensuring the taps are fully turned on each time

NOTICE FROM YOUR PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANY

CK AquaCare has carried out the legally required **hygiene inspection** of the communal water supply systems on behalf of your property management company.

Please follow the instructions displayed inside your flat.

The primary basis for this is provided, in particular, by the applicable provisions of the Drinking Water Ordinance and the relevant technical standards, foremost among which is DIN 806.
